

The Lapeer Community Scholarship & Student Loan Fund (LCSSLF) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation that raises funds to assist Lapeer High School graduates with college costs through scholarships and low interest student loans. The LCSSLF Board of Directors are comprised of community and business leaders, school staff and Lapeer Community Schools alumni. The Board administers all scholarship and loan funds to maximize earnings from endowments and to allocate funds each year to scholarships and loans.

CHARITABLE DONATIONS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL TAX DEDUCTIONS

Your gifts in memory of family and friends are a tribute and also can be a boost for a graduate as a scholarship. The Bill DesJardins Memorial and the Rod Parsch Memorial Scholarship are given annually and represent two men who were leaders in our school and community. The scholarships are awarded annually at the Lapeer High School Honors Convocation. Families and individuals have also donated to LCSSLF through their family trusts.

Our History

The Lapeer High School Student Loan Fund wrote its first loan in 1924. Later, the scholarship program was added. John Sak and Rod Parsch were initiators of the organization and service. The scholarships and loans have been distributed to college students who graduated from West, East, Community and Lapeer High School.

Starting college is a major financial commitment for students and parents. LCSSLF offers 10 scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each to Lapeer graduates each year. Additionally, scholarships are granted annually by the Parsch, DesJardins, Lapeer Elks and Clarke Adams scholarship funds.

Alongside our scholarship program, LCSSLF also issues low-interest loans to Lapeer graduates. The interest does not accrue, nor any payment due until the student graduates or separates from college. This often makes a huge difference for the students who can pay for college as they go, rather than to acquire great debt through other sources. As students repay their loans, LCSSLF continues to offer loans to the next class.
